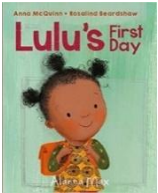
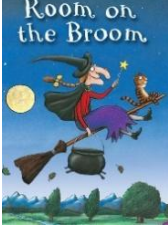
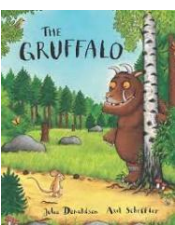
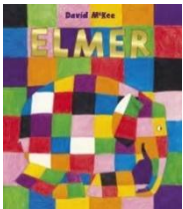
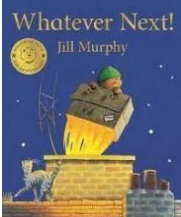
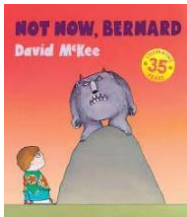
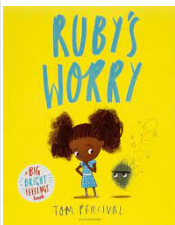
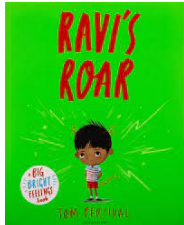
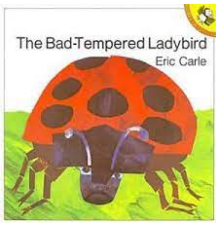
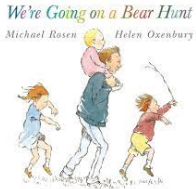
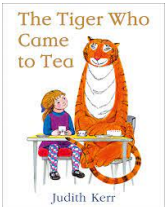
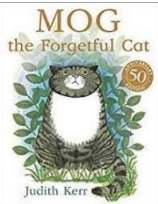
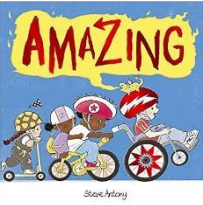
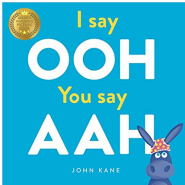
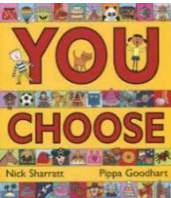
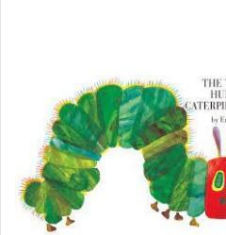
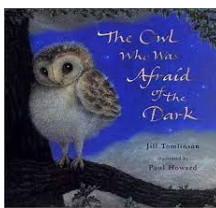
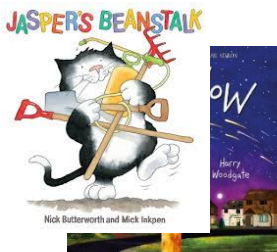
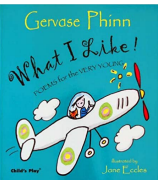
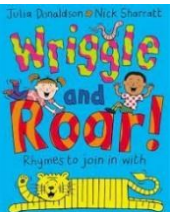
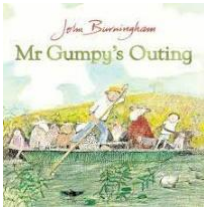
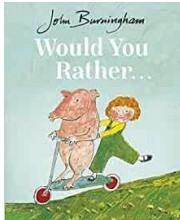
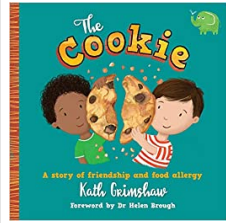
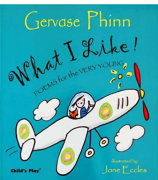
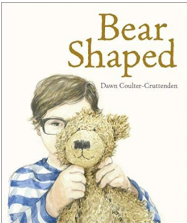
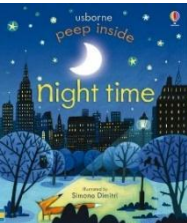
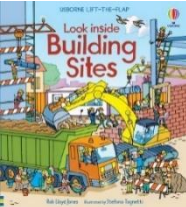
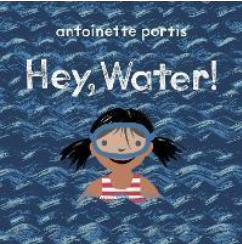
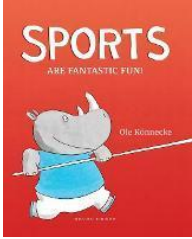
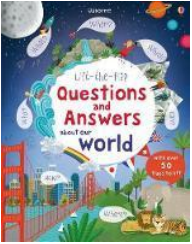
Children listen to, respond and learn a wide range of texts through their English lessons (see Writing Curriculum Progression for more details).
