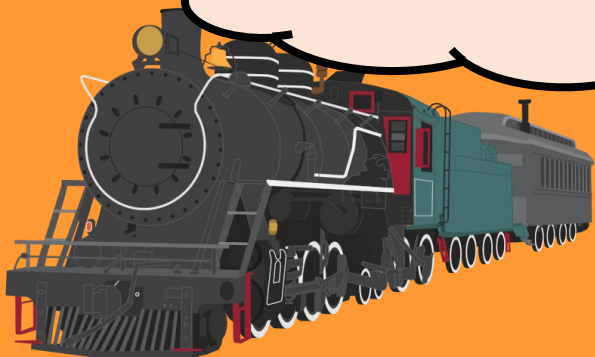


We're off on a journey

Spring

This term, our topic is "We're off on a journey". We will be learning about different vehicles and what they were used for. We will design, make and then test our own vehicles with wheels and axles to see how well they move. We will also be reading a variety of Traditional Tales.

Maths

In Maths Club, we will continue to develop our subitising skills. We will match amounts of objects to the corresponding number. We will explore two equal groups as doubles and also investigate odd and even numbers by their shapes. We will also play number track games and practise ordering numbers.

Understanding the World

Within our journey unit we will be looking at how vehicles have changed over time, using the language of past and present. The children will explore the difference between modes of transport used in different countries.

During Oracy sessions, we will practise our speaking and listening skills. We will focus on: looking at the person who is talking; using a loud, clear voice when we are talking to an audience; and, learning to ask relevant questions and make relevant comments.

Literacy

Our key texts for learning this term are:

- We're Going on a Bear Hunt*
- Goldilocks*
- Mr Gumpy's Outing*

In Writing Club, we will be writing words using our phonic knowledge to segment the words. We will continue to practise our letter formation. Our daily phonics sessions and regular reading will continue.
