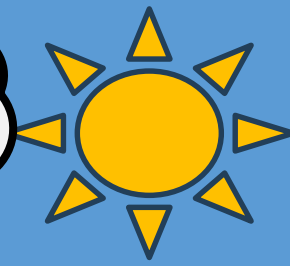


# Our Beautiful World

This term, our topic is “Our Beautiful World”. We will spend lots of time outdoors and enjoy a trip to the beach later in the term. We will learn about plants and animals, including learning how caterpillars transform into butterflies by observing our own caterpillars in each class.

## Maths

In Maths Club, we will continue to develop our understanding of number through our “Mastering Number” program of study. We will learn about odd and even numbers and also doubles. We will be using the Rekenrek piece of maths equipment to show how numbers are made of smaller numbers and also how numbers above 10 are formed.

## Literacy

Our key texts this unit of learning are:

- The Very Hungry Caterpillar
- The Bad Tempered Ladybird
- The Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch

In Writing Club, we will be writing sentences, using tricky words and using our phonic knowledge to segment the words. We are continuing to practise our letter formation. Our daily Little Wandle phonics sessions and reading three times a week will continue.

## Understanding the World

We are learning about the natural world including animals and insects. We will learn about different types of birds. We will also be comparing the town to the coast and observing how the school outdoor environment changes as the Summer season develops.

## Managing Feelings and Behaviour

We will continue to explore feelings and positive behaviours through our Jigsaw programme and our Pilton Learning Heroes. We will learn about the move into our Year One Classes and meet our new classes.

In Oracy, we will continue to develop our speaking and listening skills. We will practise looking at the person who is talking and using a loud clear voice when speaking to an audience. We are learning to ask relevant questions and make relevant comments.
